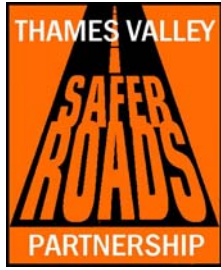

Man Charged with Perjury & Driving Whilst Disqualified – Banbury

A Luton man will appear at Banbury Magistrate's Court on Friday (25 July) after being charged with 3 counts of Perjury and a variety of other offences.

Waseem KHAN, 23, of Flint Close, Luton was charged on Wednesday with 3 counts of perjury, driving whilst disqualified, driving without insurance and obtaining a pecuniary advantage. He has been bailed to appear at Banbury Magistrate's Court on Friday.

The charges relate to three speed offences detected by Safety Cameras in which Mr Khan's private hire vehicle was identified and fictitious details were allegedly supplied to the police.

Mr Khan was arrested and charged by Police when they caught him driving the private hire vehicle whilst disqualified.
